Summary	The purpose of this policy is to outline the conditions under which Kurrawa Surf Life Saving Club members may store their personally owned gear and equipment at the Club for the upcoming season.

Purpose of the Policy:

To provide financial members with the opportunity to store their personally owned surf lifesaving or training equipment at Kurrawa SLSC at their own discretion and risk.

For the purpose of this policy, "gear and equipment" refers to lifesaving racing mals, skis, double skis, and paddles.

Conditions of Storage:

- 1. Members must be current financial members of Kurrawa SLSC to be eligible to store their personally owned gear and equipment in the Club's basement.
- Members must submit a new online application each season for storage of personal equipment at the Club. Items are permitted only in the allocated areas using the numbering system.
- 3. All equipment remains the personal property of the member and must be clearly labelled with the owner's name and stored in their specifically allocated numbered location.
- 4. Kurrawa SLSC accepts no responsibility or liability for any loss, theft, or damage to personal equipment while stored at the Club or during Club activities.
- 5. Members storing equipment at the Club do so entirely at their own risk and are encouraged to ensure their personal items are covered under their own insurance.
- 6. Other items, such as surfboards or paddle boards, may be stored in the Club basement if space permits and an online application is submitted. Priority will be given to lifesaving gear and equipment.
- 7. Empty board covers should not be stored at the Club and must be taken home to avoid unnecessary clutter.
- 8. All equipment stored must be thoroughly washed down after use to remove sand and debris before being returned to the basement. This helps prevent sand from being transferred onto other members' craft.



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- 9. Members must not move or remove another member's craft unless prior arrangement or approval has been granted.
- 10. The Club reserves the right to request removal of personal equipment at any time, including during periods of renovation, reallocation of space, or non-compliance with this policy.
- 11. Equipment left unclaimed after notice may be removed at the discretion of the Senior Gear & Equipment Officer.

Compliance and Consequences:

Members who fail to comply with this policy may lose the privilege of storing personal equipment at the Club.

Review and Updates:

This policy is valid from 21st October 2025 and will be reviewed as required.
