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Maroochyshore Surf Life Saving Club in partnership with World Ocean Series are proud to present the Murphy Homes Maroochy Classic commencing Friday 23 January and finishing Saturday 24 January 2026 on Maroochyshore Beach.

The Shaw and Partners World Ocean Series returns to the Sunshine Coast for the Murphy Homes Maroochy Classic 7,000, set for 23–24 January 2026 at the iconic Maroochyshore Surf Life Saving Club.

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Now with over \$70,000 in cash and prizes on the line and 7,000 critical series points up for grabs, this is one of the biggest and most influential events on the summer racing calendar

The Maroochy Classic is Australia's longest running club-run surf carnival beginning way back in 1967! It has been conducted almost uninterrupted for 59 years and attracts the best surf sports athletes from around the world. The Sunshine Coast's own local builder Murphy Homes has been the major sponsor for the carnival since 2011 – 16 consecutive years!

In 2026 we also welcome XXXX to the beach and Century 21 On Duport have come on board as our Beach Arena sponsor.

This document outlines some the final information relating to the 2026 Murphy Homes Maroochy Classic. Please note that SLSQ may have subsequent bulletins or circulars which may supersede information provided in this circular.

1. COMPETITION COMMITTEE

The Competition Committee (CC) will direct all matters relating to the actual conduct of the competition. The CC may, in accordance with the rules contained in the current edition of the *Surf Sports Manual*, any subsequent amending bulletins and this circular, postpone, cancel and or alter any or all events at the Championships, and/or alter the venue of the competition.

The CC may consult and seek advice from appropriate officials, athletes and other personnel on competition conditions and safety issues when required. The CC shall appoint the various sub committees and panels as required for the event e.g. Disciplinary Committee & Coach/Athlete Panel.

Open Mixed Taplin Relay team nominations will be made at the Saturday team managers meeting, with forms to be returned on the day between 7-9 AM. Clubs will be permitted to enter one team per club. Should there be additional space in the final, clubs may submit a second team, which will be allocated in order of host club followed by highest club entries until the final is full.

All Team event nominations need to be completed on Saturday morning at the team Managers meeting. **Teams can only consist of athletes nominated in an individual event.**

Team Managers will have until 30 minutes prior to marshalling on competition day to register late competitor entries with Administration (fees apply).

On the day entries (ie entries after the close of late entries on Thursday 23rd January) will incur an administration fee of \$50 on top of normal entry fees.

5. COMPETITOR LISTING

The competitor listing for the Murphy Homes Maroochy Classic 2026 will be available on Live Heats. Athletes must have a Live Heats band registered to their name. Replacement Live Heats bands will be available for purchase at the check-in area, and wristbands can also be reprogrammed here. Athletes are to ensure they get scanned after every race to receive points and be progressed correctly.

6. EVENT ADMINISTRATION

Event administration area for registration will be open Friday 23rd 2026 from 1pm – 4pm and Saturday 24th January 2025 from 6am – 8am. The registration area will be located under the Lifeguard Tower immediately south of the Maroochy SLSC clubhouse. Athletes will receive one hat and one competition rashie for the carnival.

Official Murphy Homes Maroochy Classic competition rashie must be worn in all events and presentations. Winners and placegetters must wear Murphy Homes Maroochy Classic competition rashie and hat on the podium for official presentation and photos.

8. MARSHALLING PROCESS

Event heats will be drawn prior to the event. All individual events will marshal on the line as per last year. Athletes are required to KNOW THEIR HEAT NUMBER & LANE and report to the start line in their lane. WE WILL NOT WAIT FOR YOU! Athletes must have their Live Heats band on to race – no exceptions. All remaining team events will marshal on the line with the 3rd paddler of each team scanning the team in.

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9. ATHLETE/COACH ADVISORY PANEL

The Carnival Committee (CC) may appoint an Athlete/Coach Advisory Panel for this event. The Panel will be made up of a mix of athletes and coaches and will be a resource for the Carnival Referee and Sectional Referees. This Panel will also be able to take any issues to the Carnival Committee during the running of the event if necessary.

10. RESULTS

LiveHeats will be used throughout the duration of the Carnival. All competitors are required to wear their LiveHeats wrist band. If a competitor does not have their wrist band with them, they will need to purchase a replacement wrist band for \$5.00 prior to marshalling. **Cash only.**

Results and round progressions will automatically become available on LiveHeats.

11. EVENT MEDALS, TROPHIES & POINTSCORE

Local clubs will be required to provide IRB water safety support based on competitor entry numbers for their club. These clubs to be advised asap after regular entries close.

16. TEAM MANAGER DECLARATIONS

Clubs are to ensure their respective Team Managers complete the Team Managers Declaration so that respective correspondence can be circulated to them as well as ensuring that Team Managers are linked to their athletes through Live Heats. 17. GEAR TRAILER/VEHICLE PARKING/TENTS

Parking on nature strips, areas of open space and parkland is not permitted and on the spot fines may be issued for any vehicle parked illegally. No liability will be accepted by Maroochy SLSC for illegal parking. All clubs, competitors and officials are to read and obey the parking signs set up by the Sunshine Coast Regional Council

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and the Carnival Committee. Any vehicles that are illegally parked that results in an infringement notice will be the responsibility of the vehicle owner.

Use of the dunal areas is prohibited during the event. To protect the dunal area, only formal beach access ways are to be used for access and all signage and fencing must be observed for coastal protection. Club tents are not to be erected on the sand dunes – by direction of the Carnival Referee and Sunshine Coast Regional Council. All clubs are to respect the signs located on the beach in regard to tents on the dunes. Any club that fails to follow the signs will be asked to move their tent.

Tents can be erected from 7am Friday 23rd January.

No parking in the southern carpark next to the Maroochy Surf Club – this area is allocated to vendors.

Gear Trailer Parking access is available at Pierce Park, Alexandra Parade, Maroochydore from 5pm Thursday 22nd January. Further descriptions on this can be seen in the site map below. All club, competitors and officials are to read and obey the parking signs set up by the Sunshine Coast Council and the Carnival Committee. Pierce Park, Maroochydore



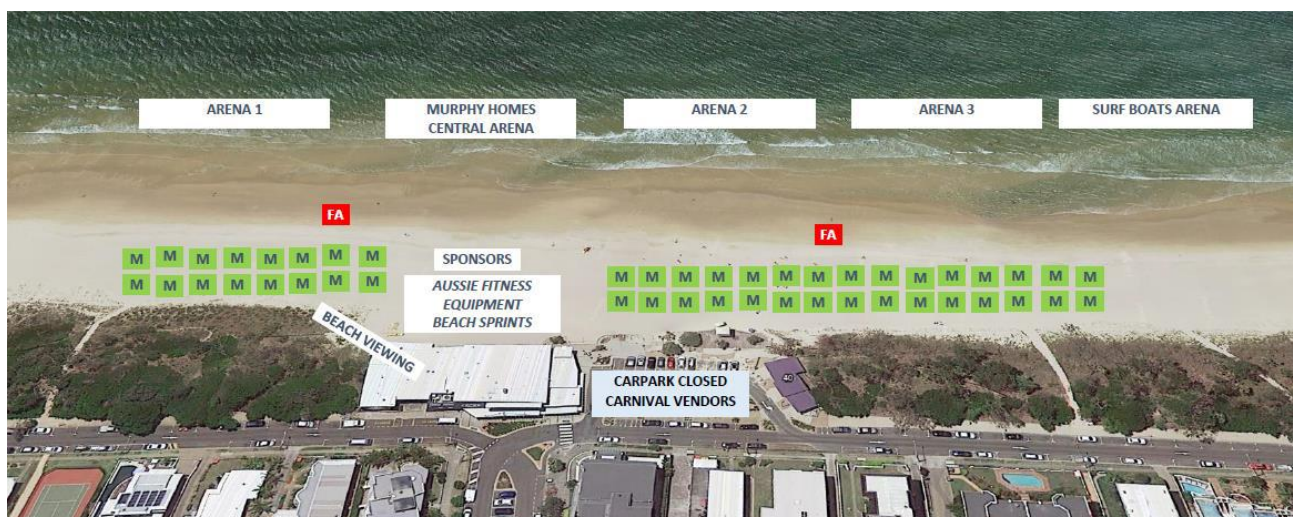
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Club tents may be set up within the designated area from 7am Friday 23rd January

18. MEDIA & PHOTOGRAPHY

Drones:

For the safety of competitors, officials and spectators SLSQ prohibits the use of drones or Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) at this event by members and/or public.

All competitors racing agree to have one broadcast drone in the racing arena during the finals package.

Photography:

As a condition of entry, all competitors agree to have photos and video taken during the event used for promotional material by SLSQ.

Photographers within the carnival area must have a visible photographer's pass as well as their BlueCard.

19. SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering at this event will be conducted randomly throughout this event by appointed scrutineering officials.

20. CANCELLATION POLICY

If the carnival is cancelled with no postponement before the first event is conducted, a 75% refund will be issued.

If the carnival is cancelled after the first event is conducted, no refund will be given.

If a carnival is postponed and rescheduled to another date, a 75% refund will be issued to competing Clubs that cannot compete at the rescheduled event.

21. BEHAVIOUR/MISCONDUCT

Any misconduct while at the event will not be tolerated. This includes the days leading into the competition and any official social activities following the conclusion of the event. Offending members risk disciplinary action against both themselves and their Clubs.

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Please refer to the current Surf Sports Manual sections 2.27 *SLSA Code of Behaviour* and 2.28 *Abuse/Inappropriate behaviour* and the Policy 6.5 *Member Protection Policy* (available online at the Members Portal).

22. PROTESTS

All protests shall be lodged with the appropriate Sectional Referee in each Area in accordance with procedures set down in the current edition of the Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent bulletins and shall identify the specific sections/clauses in the Competition Manual and or event rules upon which the protest is based.

Protest Forms are available from the Liaison Officer. An 'Appeals Fee' of \$110 must accompany all documentation when the process is officially submitted to the Appeals Committee for adjudication.
