

FUNDRAISING POLICY – VOLUNTEER / WATER SAFETY / OFFICIATING MEMBER ONLY

The purpose of this policy is to allow Kurrawa Members and their families the opportunity to fundraise for Surf Life Saving expenses through Kurrawa SLSC sanctioned fundraising activities.

As one of Australia's premier Surf Life Saving Clubs, Kurrawa provides service to the community through a safe beach and exceptional training and education programs from youth to elite in a family friendly, welcoming, and professional environment.

Surf Club courses, activities and camps can be expensive, this policy outlines the opportunity for members to fundraise to reduce additional costs.

1. A 3-year time limit on the use of fundraising is to be implemented, funds raised and not used within this period will be written off and returned to the Club (Kurrawa Surf Lifesaving Club).
This is to be implemented as follows:
Any funds raised prior to April 2021 will be written off as at 1 April 2024, funds raised after April 2021 will remain in the Individuals account for the period of 3 years and then be written off if not utilised. ***All funds raised between April 2018 to April 2020 will not be written off until April 2024 due to Covid-19 limiting the opportunity for members to utilise fundraising.***
2. This policy relates to all Volunteer members who complete activities such as Water Safety, however, are not competitors or have Junior Activity competitors.
3. Each Volunteer member will be provided with their own individual fundraising ledger recording the amount of funds raised and funds used. However, where it is deemed more appropriate, fundraising may be allocated to a Section as a whole and without individual allocation.
4. The Finance Manager will be responsible for maintaining the fundraising ledgers. All payments and/or reimbursements to Competitors will be based upon the balances recorded in the ledger maintained by the Finance Manager.
5. Water Safety reimbursements can be converted into points on members cards (up to \$200.00 at a time) on written application to the Operations Manager.

6. Fundraising proceeds can be used to cover the costs of Representative Teams, Leadership Camps and Carnival accommodation were endorsed by the relevant Committees.
7. Fundraising proceeds can be used to cover the costs of the Annual Dinner ticket for themselves only.
8. Should a Volunteer member leave Kurrawa SLSC, any fundraising balance remaining in their fundraising account will be transferred into general revenue.
9. At all times, the Board of Management has the discretion to make interpretations of and/or exceptions to this policy where it is felt that a Volunteer Member's circumstances warrant deviation from this policy.
10. All funds remain in the Surf Clubs Fundraising account and can be used at the Board of Managements discretion
